## ***New Gate Directory Box, Receiver, and Home Owner Remotes***

A new Chamberlain Sentex Infinity-M directory box was installed at our front entrance along with a new Chamberlain Liftmaster receiver unit. The new gate receiver works alongside the existing Genie-type receiver unit. The concrete filled posts and the steel support posts were painted with industrial enamel to complete the restoration at the front entrance.

### **New Passport Liftmaster Remotes**

The new Sentex Infinity-M directory box was installed with a new Liftmaster receiver unit that is fully integrated with the Chamberlain software. Unlike the existing Genie-type receiver unit that opens the gates, the new receiver unit does not require manual entry of every single remote in the neighborhood.

The new Liftmaster Passport remotes may only be purchased directly from your neighborhood gate assistant, currently Mike Sasso. The remotes are commercial grade and are purchased in quantity from an authorized Liftmaster distributor. The cost is \$25 per remote (either type pictured above) and checks may be made out to Specialty Management.

If you have installed a retail Liftmaster garage door opener, the new Passport remotes can be programmed to operate garage door units installed since 2005 (315-mHz systems). The older Genie garage door operators may be opened using a Liftmaster adapter for use with the new Liftmaster remotes. The adapters may also be purchased for \$25.

### **Existing Genie Remotes**

New genie remotes will no longer be programmed. However, existing Genie remotes will continue to work as long as the existing genie-compatible receiver at the front gate works. When it stops working for good, or you are simply tired of trying to make your Genie remote work, home owners will be required to buy the new Passport Liftmaster remote. The existing Genie-compatible receiver at the front gate was manufactured in Oct.1996 by a company that no longer exists and the codes cannot be recovered. Attempting to re-program over 400 remotes and cars in another Genie-based unit is not feasible and would take months to accomplish given the manual programming effort involved.

### **Additional Advantages of the New Passport Liftmaster Remotes**

- Remotes are programmed via software. If the new directory box or receiver hardware should fail in the future, all the codes can be uploaded in 30 minutes versus several weeks of manual entry with the existing Genie-type remotes.
- The new Passport Liftmaster remotes can be identified per individual user; making adds, changes, or deletions very easy. The existing system provides no tracking mechanism.
- The new Liftmaster remotes include lithium batteries and will last twice as long (approx. 5 years) versus the current alkaline batteries in the Genie remotes.
